We will again be using 'School Cloud' to book appointments and to facilitate the ten-minute virtual meeting. Please note that each child is allocated one 10-minute appointment time which can be accessed by both parents using the same appointment slot on separate devices. Once you have booked your time, you will then receive an email confirming your appointment, and in due course, receive a joining link for the meeting. Your child is very welcome to attend the meeting with you. Please note, the system will end the meeting after your allocated ten minutes.

We feel it is important that you are given the opportunity to share your child/ren's in-school learning with them. To this end, we will be sending home a selection of their books the day before the scheduled meeting. **Please ensure all books come back to school the following morning, so that they are ready for the day ahead.**

The booking of appointments will go live on **tomorrow (Thursday 6th March) at 7pm** and will close on Friday 14th March at 5pm. Should you wish to make any changes after this date, please contact the school office.
